1. Apologies for absence: Rakesh Gulati, Ian Swallow and Stewart Hefferman.

2. Matters Arising: There were no matters arising from the minutes of last year's AGM

3. Chairman's Report: The Chairman was pleased with the condition and progress of the club; he was thanked for his continuing dedication to the club.

4. Finance Report:

- AK reported another year of surplus in 2015/16: some expected costs did not arise at the end of the year but will arise in 2016/17. There were further reductions in electricity costs
- The accounts for 2015/16 were presented and accepted: proposed by JRM and seconded by Anita Crosbie
- It was proposed that our Auditors (Nunn & Co) should be retained for a further year: proposed by Phil Hudson and seconded by JRM

5. Membership:

- JRM presented the latest Membership statistics which showed a further decline in membership of 5%. This was accounted for by a decline in Family membership. Membership revenue for the year to October 2017 is projected to be £10500
- It was agreed that there was no need to increase any fees
- Gayhurst school (12 pupils) are using the courts on Thursday afternoons as an After-School club, and 4 pupils from RGS are using the courts on Wednesdays as a PE lesson
- The BA club in Cranford is closing: JRM will contact their secretary to offer membership to players who are in our area

6. House:

- The roof will have its annual inspection
- Phil Hudson agreed to investigate the shower problems and to propose a solution to their instability
- The courts will be cleaned on 17/18th of August
- The men's changing room will be totally redecorated after we have solved the shower problems

7. Teams:

- DS reported that the 1st team will probably finish 2nd in the Bucks 1st division
- The Vintage team were enjoying a late run of success in the 3rd division of the Middlesex league

10. Re-election of Directors:

- AK and AC resigned and were re-elected.
- Ainsley Kemps gave notice that he would like to resign from his position as Treasurer in the coming months and DS agreed to advertise the position
