1. **Apologies** for absence: Stewart Hefferman, Ian Swallow and Nick Hallchurch

2. **Matters Arising**

There were no matters arising from the last AGM; the defibrillator has been purchased and installed by GXMC

3. **Chairman**

The chairman was unanimously thanked for his constant devotion and care of the club

4. **Membership**

- JM presented the latest Membership statistics which showed a broadly stable membership at 190 of which 50 were new members
- JRM and RG resigned and were reinstated as Directors of the Club
- There will be an Open day at GXMC on 16th May in which we will actively participate in order to attract new members

5. **Finance**

- AK presented draft accounts for 2013/14; once again he drew attention to the ever- increasing electricity usage due mainly in the past to poorly controlled heating and to the decreasing income from court payments
- JRM proposed adoption of the accounts, seconded by AK
- AK and JRM drew attention to the proposed increased subscription rates to GXMC which might be implemented in 2015/16; if imposed, the Committee would need to increase annual membership fees
- The accountants, Nunn Hayward were thanked and reappointed: proposed by AC and seconded by RG

6. **House**

- Heating controls have been linked to the court lights and as an experiment the balcony heaters will be turned off permanently
- The court walls will be washed and repaired in August
- RC will investigate the state of the men's dressing room and propose improvements.

7. **Teams**

- The first team came 4th in the 1st division of the Buckinghamshire league
- The Veterans team were 4th out of 9 teams the 3rd division of the Middlesex league
